One position for Assistant Professor

(Public and Healthcare Management & Policy)

Bocconi University is considered the leading university in Management and Economics in Italy and one of the most prestigious European academic institutions. The Department of Institutional Analysis and Public Management, where the new Assistant Professor will be based, gathers scholars from a variety of backgrounds: economics, management, economic history and political science. The research focus of the Department is on the analysis of how institutions develop, how they are shaped in the interplay with economic systems and their management processes and mechanisms.

Job Description.

The appointed person is expected to conduct major research projects and publish in international journals in one or more of the following fields: Public Management, Public Administration, Health Care Management, Health Policy, Management of Non Profit Organisations. The position requires to teach an introductory course in Public Management at undergraduate level and advanced courses in public administration, healthcare management & policy and related fields in graduate, master's and PhD programs. The annual teaching load is 105 hours. The position is for three years, renewable once. Excellent performance in research and teaching may lead to a tenured position of Associate Professor.

Requirements and competences:

PhD degree ;

Research experience beyond PhD work in the above-mentioned fields (preferred);

Fluency in written and spoken English (essential);

At least 1 publication and 1 paper submitted in a major international journal (preferred);

Attitude to and experience of teaching in undergraduate and graduate courses;

Knowledge of Italian language is not required (but availability to learn Italian is strongly encouraged).

Remuneration

Remuneration is competitive according to international standards. Bocconi University has recently introduced new criteria to reward faculty members who publish in top international journals.
