We are looking for a person with documented experience of research at an international level within medical management and the ability to lead the continuing development of the Medical Management Centre, established in 2002. A broad experience in the field will be highly valued. In addition, the successful candidate is expected to participate in graduate and postgraduate education and to contribute to the cooperation between Karolinska Institutet and Stockholm County Council in their joint development of healthcare services in the region.

The qualifications required for the post as professor are both academic and pedagogical skills. In the evaluation of the applicants, particular emphasis will be placed on the quality, scope and volume of their research. In addition, the ability to secure external research funding at the domestic or international level is also highly valued. Good leadership skills and managerial experience in an academic environment are also required. Given the required involvement in healthcare improvement with indirect or direct implications for patients the appointee should have a health professions education.

In the assessment of the applicant's merits, the required qualifications and experience carry the following weighting factors: scientific (3), leadership, development and collaboration (3) and pedagogical (1).
